2024 THEME: Sparkling Splendor: Our Diamond Anniversary Christmas

We are looking for dazzling floats with shimmering decorations and/or a touch of elegance that will showcase the brilliance of diamonds during this holiday season.

- All entries MUST be decorated for the holidays and be WELL **LIGHTED.** This is a nighttime parade so lights are necessary for the **SAFETY** of parade attendees and participants, as well as for their entertainment value. Headlights do not count towards lighting your vehicle. If your vehicle is not decorated and/or has only minimal lights you will not be allowed to participate in the parade. Walkers should have lights or glow sticks on every person.
- Marching bands, walkers, etc. MUST be in uniform, costume, or wear holiday-appropriate attire.
- All participants are required to keep pace with the parade marshal, keeping gaps to a minimum between groups/floats to ensure a smooth and continuous parade.
- Santa is not allowed on any entry. There is only ONE Santa and he is found on the last float. No one else is allowed to dress as Santa and he is not to be depicted in life-like decorations.
- ABSOLUTELY NO CANDY CAN BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES. Candy is to be passed out by walking participants ONLY. To keep the parade moving quickly, candy should be "underhand tossed" BEHIND the barriers lining Michigan Avenue (into parking spaces). The goal is to keep candy out of the center of the road and people/children out of the way of parade vehicles. VIOLATORS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE AND NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FUTURE PARADES.
- Gun shots and cannons are not allowed. Live fire/flames are allowed only with special permission.
- Any group containing animals MUST include a clean-up crew. No one wants to step in a mess!
- Vehicles on trailers are not permitted without prior approval.
- If you want your float judged, make sure to come with 2 people who can carry your banner if you win.
- Parade is not lined up in first-come, first-in-line fashion. As much as possible: music entries are spaced out, horses are kept away from fires and loud groups, etc. We rotate annual entries to try to be fair.
- No parade entry can be taller than 14-feet.

FINAL APPROVAL OF PARTICIPATION AND DECORATION OF ENTRY WILL BE HELD AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHRISTMAS COMMITTEE.

Please read all of the requirements *carefully* and fill out the application *completely*. Incomplete applications WILL NOT be accepted.
